The adhesion properties of CRYL TERZIA are very good, they can be used on almost all surfaces, provided they are free of dust and grease. Ideal are all open-pored substrates such as acrylic paper, cardboard, stretched-canvases, wood and modelling materials. The fast-drying colours can be used directly from the bottle.

Medium

Primers. The ideal preparation for the painting support is a uniform application of a primer. With LUKAS Gesso you get a mildly absorbent "half chalk" surface, which supports the ideal adhesion properties of acrylic paint.

Structures in Acrylic Painting. The LUKAS structure and modeling pastes are also ideally suited to create different textures for acrylic painting. There are no limits to creativity and experimentation. In order to give the paint a structure, all LUKAS structure pastes and gels can also be mixed with the acrylic colours. Be mindeful that some structure pastes might change the colour shade; you should therefore mix only small amounts for testing. Special effect surfaces can be achieved by overpainting the dried colour with transparent structural gels.

Dilution. By adding the binding agent LUKAS Acrylic Binder to the paint, acrylic colours can be thinned without loss of adhesion. A diluted acrylic colour produced in this way can also be used as a primer.

Transparent Acrylic colour. An acrylic paint can be applied whilst diluted with water. However, if the structure is to remain intact, it is recommended to use LUKAS transparent gel, which makes the acrylic colours more transparent and dries water-in-soluble and silky-gloss with little or no loss of structure. In order to additionally increase the gloss and the brilliance of the colour, LUKAS acrylic painting gels in glossy or silk matt finish are suitable.

Protecting the surface. If a finished acrylic painting is to be protected, the LUKAS acrylic spray varnishes – in gloss, matt and semi-matt - are particularly suitable. They are universally applicable, fast drying and after drying water repellent and benzine-, impact- and scratch-resistant. LUKAS Cryl Varnish are also available in a liquid version. These resin varnishes are quick-drying, elastic and non-yellowing..

Layers painting. The fast drying time of acrylics makes it ideal for working in layers. As the colour dries completely waterproof, the subsequent layers are not dissolved or mixed. A special challenge of layering is the technique of working from dark to light. Here, a dark ground is first applied, which is then lightened in several steps. For the surface to show through different degrees, work irregularly and with a translucent colour.
